Dear Friend,

In 1990 Fr. Raymond Murray published his book *The SAS in Ireland*. It shows quite convincingly that the British army has been employing a shoot to kill policy in the North of Ireland. His book also gives further support to the information provided by the former British Army Intelligence Officer Mr Fred Holroyd that the British authorities use death squads in Ireland.

With the assistance of Fr. Murray, a number of people who have had relatives killed - either by the British security forces in suspicious circumstances or in supposedly sectarian killings where there is strong evidence of British complicity - have come together to form a relatives organisation.

On Saturday April 20th at 1pm in St Patricks Hall Dungannon, we will hold a conference in order to formally set up a relatives for justice campaign. This meeting will be attended by people from throughout Northern Ireland who have lost loved ones in such circumstances as well as relatives of the victims of the Dublin 1974 bombing. The purpose of this body will be to campaign for justice and to seek an end to state terror.

Among those to address the conference will be a number of prominent lawyers including Peter Madden of Madden & Finucane solicitors.

On behalf of the new group, I would like to invite your organisation to send an observer to this conference. If you are unable to come, we would welcome a message of support. This convention is being sponsored by Gareth Pierce, the lawyer for the Birmingham Six and Guildford Four.
