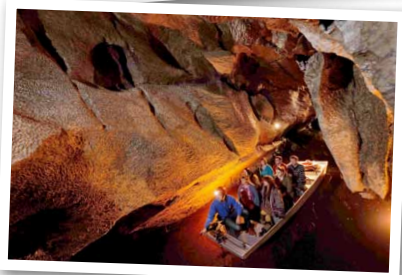
Marble Arch Caves, Fermanagh **SATURDAY 30 SEPTEMBER 2017**
